NEW MUSIC MAKERS Committee Meeting Minutes 3 December 2024

5. Finance

Treasurer report to 30 November 2024.

Total assets £6934. Making Music fee for 2025 paid of £230, and silver insurance £107. Christmas concert has brought in some ticket sales, and donations for draw prizes of £103.

Following singing at Bishops Waltham Christmas market, we received £50 to help cover pianist's fee and took a collection of £29 towards our nominated charity, Southampton City Mission. Also received Easyfundraising payment £38.

We have paid out £310 for some new music. The £740 under "other" includes the fish and chip income £200 and donations for Lillian's present of £292. Our deposit for the shuffleboard of £100 has been returned to us. The net surplus after paying for the hire of the hall for the shuffleboard was £84, compared with £162 earlier in the year.

We have received £100 from St John's as a thank you for the concert done for them in July.

The tickets for the Christmas concert are selling well, 101 sold for the afternoon and 50 sold for the evening so far.

Facebook is being updated with information on Local Vocals etc and has had lots of views. Some tickets have been sold via a Botley magazine and Forget Me Not so we are reaching a new audience.
